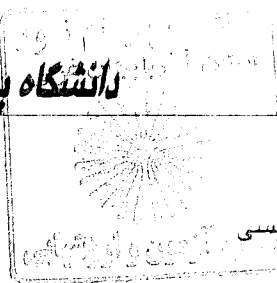

All the important parts of the body, bones, muscles, joints, nerves, and all vital organs, are cramped into inactivity and become sluggish and practically lifeless. 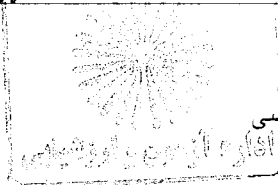

No one knows how language began. Because all people who are not handicapped have the ability to speak, language has probably existed at least as long as the modern human species. Most scholars believe that language developed very slowly from sounds, such as grunts, barks, and hoots, made by prehuman creatures. According to this view, a simple system of vocal communication became more and more complex as the human brain and speech organs evolved. But no one knows when or how this process took place. In fact, there is no record of language for most of its existence. The first real evidence of language is writing. But scholars believe that writing did not appear until thousands of years after the origin of spoken language. The earliest known written records are Sumerian cuneiform and Egyptian hieroglyphics from about 3000 B.C. Written Chinese dates from perhaps 1500 B.C., Greek from about 1400-B.C., and Latin from about 500 B.C.
