2. There are a few children who in spite of the best "techniques" used by teacher and parent, cannot "adjust" to nursery school within a reasonable length of time. If this is the case, the idea of school attendance should be given up for the time being and postponed to some later date.
3. The preschool period can be a happy time in family life, free from overwhelming problems. One reason for this is that the preschool child can do so much more for himself. He can be quite independent in feeling himself, in dressing, and in using the toilet.
4. Once he starts school, home is no longer the sole focus of the child's interests. He has, in a way, a life of his own. Thus, with the young child who has "his" school, even as with the older person with diversified interests, things that may go wrong at home are of less paramount importance.
5. Teacher's attitude needs to be one that not only includes kindness and concern; but also respect for the child and his abilities. Such an attitude is conducive to the active involvement of the child in the learning process. Perhaps the greatest emphasis in this text will be given to the concept that children learn by involvement in the adventure of learning.
6. Equipment used in nursery school is to be enjoyed, but it also should be designed to help a child learn specific skills and concepts. Simple equipment that is well made with these qualifications best serves the nursery school child. Too complex equipment will only frustrate a child and this is particularly true in the first weeks of school.
