**Part Two: Translation****Instruction: Translate the following passage in to Farsi:**

1. It is through the Assyrian records that we first hear of the Medes and Persians. Shalmaneser III, when fighting against a revolt in the Zagros mountain region to the east of his country, in 836 BC came into contact with the Persian chiefs of Parsua and made them pay tribute.
2. Darius I ruled the empire from 522 to 486 BC. During the early years of his reign, he suppressed the revolts of subject peoples and in improving the administrative organization of the state. He completed the division of the empire into provinces, and fixed the annual tribute due from each province.
3. In Athens political and personal freedom was encouraged, and a democratic government was formed. In the 5th century, after forcing back a Persian invasion of Greece, Athens enjoyed a Golden Age. Important discoveries were made in science, mathematics, and medicine, and masterpieces were created in literature, sculpture and architecture.
4. Born in 1469, Machiavelli served his native city of Florence for many years as a diplomat and government official. After he retired, he wrote *the prince*, intending it as a realistic set of rules by which a strong ruler could create a unified government for Italy and ward off invasions by other newly powerful European nations.
5. The period of the Commercial Revolution had seen the invention of the pendulum clock, the thermometer, the air pump, the spinning wheel, and the techniques of smelting ores and making brass. There were also important technological advances in such industries as glass blowing, and clock making.
